# Topical Meeting

## Reverberation Chamber, Anechoic Chamber & OATS Users' Group Meeting

The Users' Group Meeting will take place February 14-16, 2005 in conjunction with EMC Zurich 2005 in three half-day sessions.

Papers addressing reverberation chamber, anechoic chamber and OATS test methodology are solicited. The following topics are of particular interest:

- **Comparison of different test environments (RC, AC, (G)TEM, OATS, 3D-TEM etc.)**
- **Optimization of RF performance (LUF, statistical field isotropy, etc.)**
- **Simulation of RC, AC, (G)TEM, etc.**
- **New issues in test procedure standardization**
- **Testing of unusually large, complex, broadband EUTs, EUTs exhibiting irregular radiation patterns or requiring extraordinary field strengths**

The meeting will begin on Monday, February 14, afternoon with an invited talk and an optional half-day tutorial/workshop. Tuesday, February 15, afternoon and Wednesday, February 16, morning will feature technical presentations. The technical sessions of EMC Zurich 2005 beginning on Tuesday, February 15, will be scheduled so as not to interfere with the Users' Group Meeting.

EMC Zurich 2005 will also feature a large EMC exhibition accessible to all participants of the Users' Group Meeting.
